CAREER & COUNSELING CELL 2015-16

The Career & Counseling cell has taken SBMM to new heights this year. Under the aegis of Career & Counseling Cell, following activities were conducted during the academic year 2015-16.

1. As a part of the consultation activity, Career & Counseling cell counseled about 15 college students on various issues, related to career prospects, family problems, study related problems. Also 10 students from School & other colleges were counseled, aptitude tests were conducted, and Rs. 25,000/- revenue was generated through this consultation.
2. A formal MOU was signed by the college and Niramay Bahu-Uddeshiya Sewa Sanstha, Nagpur for under talking various psychometric tests for their CSR activity projects. As a part of the MOU, the first assignment was successfully completed on 31st March 2016. A team of six students & the coordinator Mr. Amar Damle, conducted aptitude tests of 29 students, of 9th & 10th standard of the selected villages of Niramay. The students and their parents were counseled subsequently. The analysis & interpretation of the aptitude tests was done by the team. A revenue of Rs.25,000/- was generated from this unique activity.
3. The career counseling cell further extended its activities to various schools, like Ramesh Chandak English Medium School, Lokanchi Shala, etc and conducted Aptitude tests of 10th appearing students. In total 50 students were being counseled. A total revenue of Rs 3,000/- was generated through this consultation.
4. WAD-Workshop on Attitude Development was conducted on 21th & 22nd March 2016. Since last 3 years i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2015-16, WAD is being organized free of cost for our college students. This year the theme was specially designed for the students to be motivated to become entrepreneurs. In-fact the modules were designed for final & second year students. 62 students participated and got benefitted of the modules. The workshop was inaugurated at the hands of Mrs. Suchita Marathe (In-charge-IQAC), in presence of WAD convener Prof. Amar Damle.

CAREER & COUNSELING CELL 2014-15

Under the aegis of Career Development Cell, following activities were conducted during the academic year 2014-15.

1. In the month of September 2014, the career counseling cell and English department conducted a three days English Enhancement workshop (15th to 17th September 2014). About 110 students of our college participated in the workshop. The focus was on developing the communication skills & Basic English language in our students. The workshop was conducted by our in-house faculties, Dr.Suchita Marathe (HOD), Dr.Rajshri Gajghate, Mrs.Archana Gupta. Excellent feedback was given by the participants suggesting more elaborative workshops can be conducted for the students in the coming year.

2. WAD-Workshop on Attitude Development was conducted on 20th & 21st December 2014. Since last 2 year i.e. 2012-13 & 2013-14, WAD is being organized free of cost for our college students. This year the theme was specially designed for the students to help them in placements. In-fact the modules were designed for final & second year students. 53 students participated and got benefitted of the modules. The workshop was inaugurated at the hands of Mrs. Suchita Marathe (In-charge-IQAC), in presence of WAD convener Prof. Amar Damle.

For the event total expenses proposed to UGC under 12th Plan were Rs.40000/-.
The actual expenses for 2014 were Rs. 10,200/-.

3. A special workshop for developing memory & moral boosting by Mr. Amar Damle was conducted for 12th standard students of our college. The two hours interactive workshop was conducted in the month of January 2015. Approximately 100 students from Marathi & Hindi medium were benefitted from the workshop.
4. About 30 students from our college & 5 students from other colleges were counseled for selection of appropriate careers after graduation.

CAREER & COUNSELING CELL 2013-14

The new session of 2013-14 began in the month of June 2013. With substantial number of admissions, the classes began with zeal. The Principal invited the 5 teaching staff members to be a part of the committee, which will take care of the competitive exams coaching center. It was proposed by Dr. Shambharkar that Mr. Amar Damle would be the coordinator and conduct the activity, which was unanimously decided.

The students were informed in the regular classes about the various job oriented competitive exams that are coming in Sept to Jan-2014. It was decided that all SC, ST & NT students would be given coaching free of charge, and other students would be charged Rs.500/- for the session. In total 55 Students registered by filling up forms giving their academic and other details required for forms filling. 22 students paid Rs.500/- fees (10 Ex-Students) and a total of Rs.11, 000/- was deposited with the office.

Since 2011 the competitive exams coaching centre is being regularly doing its activities (without UGC grant). The first year students are to be enrolled more so that they would be given input for 3 years to get the desired result. In the month of November 2013 a special workshop was conducted by Mr.Satish Phadke (Director Phadke Academy for Competitive Exams, Akola) for 3 days on Mathematics and fast calculations. All students attended the workshop and were extremely benefitted with the inputs.

Even during the winter vacations (November 2013) classes were conducted and students were prepared for Staff Selection Commission, Gramin Banks Exams, and SBI-IBPS exam. The

classes began from 1st of August 2013 and Ended on 31st January2014, as university practical & colleges' exams were from Feb 2014. Mr. Damle conducted the classes throughout the year.

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Workshop on Attitude Development (WAD 2013) was conceptualized under the banner of Career Development Cell (Under UGC Grant) with the purpose of developing zeal, confidence, and enhancing employability of ARTS students.

This year WAD was specially designed for our college students only and conducted as per schedule for 2 days i.e. 21st and 22nd Dec 2013. The workshop was inaugurated at the hands of Mrs. Snehal Paldhikar (Principal SBMM), and Career Development Cell coordinator Mr. Amar Damle was present. WAD-2013 was conducted in the NEW hall using all the latest ICT tools.

There were in total 28 participants (22 final year, 4 second year & 2 first year) from our college. The scheduled time for each day was 10 to 5 PM
