### **DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES 2014-15**

- **English Language Enhancement Programme-2014-15-** A programme for English Language Enhancement was organized by the Department of English ON 15<sup>th</sup> ,16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of September 2014. Total 110 students participated in the workshop. The workshop was organized with the objective of enthusing the students towards learning English albeit in a Playway method.

On the first day, the workshop focused on Vocabulary Development. Various games were taken to make the students recall words, idioms, phrases and proverbs. On the second day, the students were shown audio-visual clips and their comprehension and observation skills were tested. Students enjoyed it very much. On the third day students were asked to prepare tree-diagrams, comprehend an unseen passage and write answers to some simple grammatical exercises. They were also asked to attempt a picture description.

Thus the workshop concentrated on the development of all the four skills of language. Ms. Marathe, Head of the Department, and other members of the Department of English like Ms Gajghate, Ms Gupta, Ms Lengde and Ms Chawke took efforts for the success of the programme.
